 Concerning the As of Date, Chief Elevator Inspector Lawrence Kreseski says (8-22-08): (Quote)In the past, the contract date between the elevator company and the owner was the effective date. However, there was a time limitation of three years from that contract date before the most current code would have to be met. This policy is being reviewed. Technically, the letter of the law requires that the most current code be applied the day of inspection. The current policy allows consideration for a time line as stated, given the nature of the hardship or conditions.(Unquote)
